

The Government reserves the right to request specific advertising or movement of the property that the Contractor resells and that is located in Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.”

**Contract 08-0001-0001, Article Six, Section 2(A) first sentence is changed to read (in part)**, “Property that is referred for sale to Contractor shall be located within the Continental United States to include Alaska, Hawaii, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. The Government may opt to deliver property to the contractor located outside CONUS with contractor’s acceptance. The

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Government reserves the right to request specific advertising or movement of the property that the Contractor resells and that is located in Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.”
