Individual Development Plans help employees look ahead to career needs and training. The plans help DLA develop training plans and

budgets for the next fiscal year.

The IDP Open Season runs May 1 to June 15, 2024, and is used to outline desired learning and training for **FY25**.

All civilian employees, including Pathways to Career Excellence (PaCE) Benefits of an IDP

Gives employees personal responsibility and accountability for their career development and for acquiring or enhancing the skills they need to stay current in their roles.

Provides an administrative mechanism for identifying and tracking development needs and plans.


Assists in planning the agency's training and development requirements (training budget). Aligns employee training and development efforts with the agency's / organization's mission, goals, and objectives.


HOW to complete your IDP



- 1. Open LMS.
- 2. In LMS menu, selectLearning Menu > Forms
- 3. Select your **FY25 IDP**.

Submit Draft IDP for Approval

At the very bottom of the IDP, select +Add Goal.



5. Once the goal is saved, select +Add New Learning Activity at the bottom of the IDP. Add LMS courses or External Activity training (e.g. OPM courses, seminars or conferences).

At least one goal & one learning activity is needed for an IDP

- Review the IDP Resources available in the IDP for help.
- Make sure your supervisor is correct. If not, change it in <u>MyBiz+</u> (Key Services > Update MySupervisor) which will update LMS within 24 hours.
- Do not include DAU/DAWIA or Supervisor required training.
