

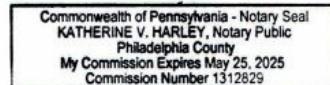

COPY OF ADVERTISEMENT

The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) has prepared a combined Remedial Investigation Report and Cleanup Plan (RIR/CP) for the former Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (DSCP) in accordance with Pennsylvania's Land Recycling and Environmental Standards Act (Act 2) Program. The site is a former Department of Defense property closed under the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Commission. The former DSCP, now commonly referred to as Quartermaster Plaza, is located at 2800 South 20th Street, Philadelphia, PA. The RIR/CP describes the nature and extent of groundwater contamination, summarizes remediation efforts to date, and provides information on future efforts to achieve closure under the Act 2 Program.

In accordance with regulatory requirements and our Public Involvement Plan, the DLA invites you to attend a public meeting where DLA will provide a summary of the remediation efforts and discuss future efforts to achieve closure. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the second public meeting will be virtual and is scheduled for March 14, 2022 6:30-8:30 PM to discuss comments received on the RIR/CP. Registration and access instructions for the virtual public meetings are available via the DLA link below.

The RIR/CP is available at the Thomas F. Donatucci, Sr. Branch of the Library of Philadelphia located at 1935 Shunk Street, Philadelphia, PA 19145. The 90-day public comment period commenced with the virtual public meeting held on December 15, 2021 and will end on March 15, 2022. As noted above a second virtual meeting will be conducted on March 14, 2022. Members of the public or interested parties may continue to submit comments on the RIR/CP via email to the DLA at DLAEnvPC@dlamail.mil through March 15, 2022 by 5 PM.
