Why Use DLA?

For the past 60 years, DLA has served as the common commodity procurement source for the U.S. military. With a staff of 26,000, including over 9,000 contracting professionals across eight major supply chains, DLA procures \$35-45 billion worth of common commodities annually on behalf of its customers, leveraging economies of scale, low overhead costs, and deep expertise in the industrial base.

Over the past decade, typically in response to national and global humanitarian crises, the demand signal for DLA's acquisition, storage, distribution, and surge capabilities to support other nonmilitary agencies has grown. DLA understands its potential value-add to the "whole of government" community as a logistics supplier of choice. It is formalizing this role as part of its latest Strategic Plan 2021-2026, while ensuring no cost or service trade-offs to its traditional military customer. 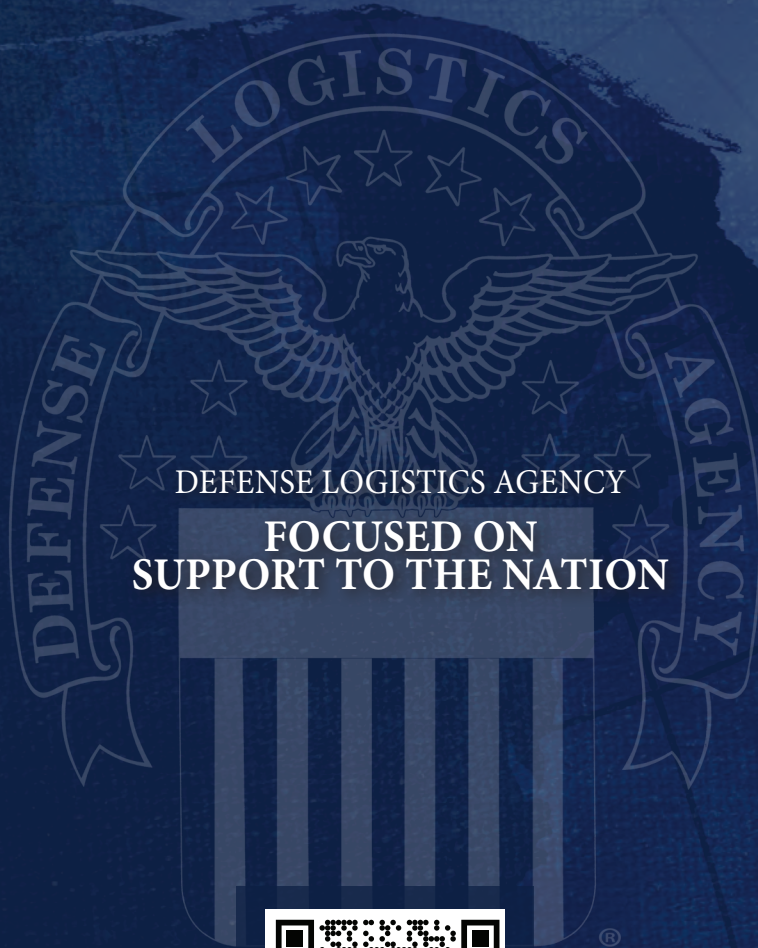
DLA is committed to meeting the US Treasury mandate to broker all intragovernmental (IGT) Buy/Sell transactions in the Governmental Invoicing system.
