I. Effective 6 June 1982

The DLA Depot Mechanization Support Office is established at the Defense General Supply Center, Richmond, Virginia, as a Management Support Activity of the Depot Operations Division, Directorate of Supply Operations. The office symbol is DMECSO.

II. Under the direction of the Chief, Depot Operations Division, Directorate of Supply Operations, the DLA Depot Mechanization Support Office is responsible for:

A. Initiating, reviewing, amending and monitoring the design, development and implementation of the Automated/Mechanized Materials Handling Systems (AMHS/MMHS).

B. Providing requirements for interface between the Automated/Mechanized Materials Handling Systems (AMHS/MMHS) and automated information systems (SAMMS, MOWASP, etc) to include integration of automated marking and reading technology.

C. Preparing technical specifications and monitoring installation of systems to assure compliance with stated objectives.

D. Reviewing Depot initiated projects as well as consultant studies, and assisting depots as required.

E. Conducting, directing, and participating in industrial and system engineering studies at DLA depots and storage sites.

III. The Defense System Automation Center (DSAC) will be responsible for on-site automated information system (AIS) support to the DMECSO mission.

IV. Administrative support for the DLA Depot Mechanization Support Office, including on-site DSAC personnel, will be furnished by the Defense General Supply Center, Richmond, Virginia.
