GENERAL ORDER
NO. 10-84

I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 16 April 1984, subject: Realignments of the Office of Plans, Policies and Programs, and the Office of the Comptroller.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 22 April 1984 the Office of the Comptroller is realigned as follows:

A. The Position Management mission, functions and related resources are transferred to DLA-L. DLA-LP herein becomes responsible for administering Position Management.

B. The Information Resources Management mission, functions and related resources are transferred to DLA-Z. DLA-ZP herein becomes responsible for the administration of the IRM Program.

C. The Survey, Standards and Management Information Systems Division (DLA-CO) is realigned in recognition of the foregoing transfers of Position Management and IRM.

D. The Position Management and Manpower Survey Branch (DLA-COP) is redesignated as the Commercial Activity and Manpower Survey Branch. DLA-COP is responsible for policy formulation and administration relative to the Commercial Activity Program; DLA Manpower Management Program administration, DLA Quality Circles Program and the DLA Work Simplification Program, and exercises staff supervision over DCAPO.

E. The Stock Fund Budget Division (DLA-CS) is redesignated the Revolving Fund Budget Division (DLA-CR) and is responsible for:

1. Policy and administration of Defense Stock Fund (DSF) and Special Defense Acquisition Fund (SDAF) budget programs.

2. Policy and administration of Defense Industrial Fund (DIF) budget program.

F. The Internal Review Division (DLA-CI) is restructured to a two branch division with no mission change.


1. The Internal Control and Review Branch (DLA-CIR) is established with Internal Control and Internal Review policy and administration responsibilities.

2. The Oversight and Analysis Branch (DLA-CIO) is established and is responsible for external audit, inspection and noncriminal investigation report program policy and administration, and exercises staff supervision over the DLA Referral Review Office (DRRO).

G. The DLA Referral Review Office (DRRO) is established as a Management Support Activity (MSA) of the Oversight and Analysis Branch and is the focal point for DoD Hotline referrals with responsibility to analyze, control, coordinate and/or investigate referred noncriminal allegations/complaints.

III. Administrative support for DLA-C, DCAPO, and DRRO will be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center. Administrative support for DPSSO will continue to be provided by the Defense General Supply Center and Defense Contract Administration Services Region Chicago, as appropriate.
