I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 28 June 1984, subject: Transfer of Operational Control of the Maintenance Directorates to DIPEC.


II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 1 October 1984, the DDMP, DDTC and DCSC Directorates of Maintenance are transferred to DIPEC.

A. The three Maintenance Directors will report directly to the DIPEC Commander.

B. Accounting and Finance, Civilian Personnel, and other support services will continue to be provided by DCSC, DDMP and DDTC under a host/tenant Memorandum of Understanding with DIPEC or by the Navy under agreement with DLA. Depot/Center support services presently provided by the Directorates of Maintenance will continue to be provided by DIPEC.

C. The Most Efficient Organization contained in the Commercial Activity (CA) Program review as approved by the Director, DLA will become the approved organization for these Directorates.
