I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 28 Jun 84 , subject: Establishment of Office for Contracting Integrity.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 1 October 1984, the Office for Contracting Integrity is established as a HQ DLA principal staff element, reporting to the Director, DLA.

III. Responsibility for taking action pursuant to Subpart 9.4, Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), to debar or suspend contractors, and to take action on the basis of violations of the Gratuities Clause, is transferred from the Office of General Counsel to the Office for Contracting Integrity. The Staff Director, Office for Contracting Integrity, is responsible for:

A. Determining on behalf of the Agency whether to debar or suspend contractors pursuant to Subpart 9.4, FAR.

B. Taking actions on the basis of violations of the Gratuities Clause.

IV. Debarment authority involving sales contracts may be delegated to DPDS and DPDR-E.

V. In the extended absence of the Staff Director, Office for Contracting Integrity, the Deputy Director (AM), DLA or the Deputy Director, DLA, in that order, will assume the above responsibilities.

VI. Administrative support will be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).

VII. The office symbol for the Office for Contracting Integrity is DLA-J.
