I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 17 May 85, subject: Realignment of DLA Commercial Activity Program Office (DCAPO).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 19 May 85, the DLA Commercial Activity Program Office (DCAPO), a DLA Comptroller Management Support Activity (MSA) is realigned.

A. Under the management, direction and control of the Comptroller, DCAPO develops and promulgates DLA-wide Commercial Activity (CA) policy, guidance, plans and procedures, and administers the DLA CA Program, System and Inventory.

B. DCAPO is structured with the establishment of:

1. Program Management Office (DCAPO-M), responsible for policy, guidance and procedural development, Management Information System administration, and program support.

2. Administrative Support Services Branch (DCAPO-A), responsible for development, coordination, and oversight of Commercial Activity management studies, Performance Work Statements (PWSs), and Quality Assurance Plans (QAPs) for administrative support functions.

3. Installation Services Branch (DCAPO-I), responsible for development, coordination, and oversight of Commercial Activity management studies, Performance Work Statements (PWSs), and Quality Assurance Plans (QAPs) for installation support functions.

4. Logistics Services Branch (DCAPO-L), responsible for development, coordination, and oversight of Commercial Activity management studies, Performance Work Statements (PWSs), and Quality Assurance Plans (QAPs) for mission support functions.

C. Principal Staff Elements (PSEs) will provide dedicated professional/technical augmentation, which may be rotated, as required to DCAPO Task Forces/Groups.

III. Administrative support for DLA-C and DCAPO will continue to be provided by the Commander, DLA Administrative Support Center.
