I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 12 July, 1985, subject: Realignment of Quality Responsibilities at HQ DLA.

II. Pursuant to above authority and effective 4 August 85, the Directorate of Quality Assurance (DLA-Q) will become the exclusive HQ DLA Quality Assurance Primary Staff Element responsible for Quality Assurance. The Quality Assurance Directorate will serve to provide advice and assistance to the Director DLA on all Quality Assurance matters and exercise staff direction over all PLFA Quality Assurance organizations within the scope of assigned responsibilities. All Quality Assurance missions and functions will be transferred from the Directorate of Contracting (DLA-P), the Directorate of Supply Operations (DLA-O) and the Directorate of Technical and Logistics Services (DLA-S). Technical Data Management and Engineering Support functions will remain part of the responsibilities of the Technical and Logistics Services Directorate.

III. The Quality Assurance Branch (DLA-PRQ) and the Veterinary Advisor (DLA-PV) of the Contracting Directorate (DLA-P) will be disestablished and the Logistics Management Division (DLA-QL) and Veterinary Advisor (DLA-QV) established within the Directorate of Quality Assurance. The Logistics Management Division will consist of an Acquisition Branch (DLA-QLA) and a Supply and Services Branch (DLA-QLB).

IV. Administrative support will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center.
