I. Authority: DLA-DD approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 4 October 1985, subject: Realignment of the Policy and Plans Division (DLA-LR).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 20 October 1985, the following actions are effective:

A. The Policy and Plans Division is disestablished.

B. The Planning Division, DLA-LL, is established. Under the direction and guidance of the Assistant Director, Office of Policy and Plans, is responsible for:

1. Development, establishment, integration and coordination of strategic long, mid and short range objectives, goals and plans and the direction, coordination, evaluation and integration of Principal Staff Element developed short-, mid-, and long-range objectives and goals.

2. Acts as the principal logistics planner for the Agency.

C. The Policy Division, DLA-LR is established under the direction and guidance of the Assistant Director, Office of Policy and Plans and consists of two subordinate branches: Policy Development and Integration Branch and Policy Analysis and Evaluation Branch.

1. The Policy Development and Integration Branch, DLA-LRI, is responsible for:

a. Development, evaluation, integration and coordination of DLA policy and programs.

b. Development, coordination and/or administration of Agency position on international logistics roles, DOD/GSA Interface issues, and logistics concepts.

2. The Policy Analysis and Evaluation Branch, DLA-LRP, is responsible for development, implementation and administration of the DLA Model Installations and Internal Control Programs.

D. The Logistics Requirements and Systems Integration Division (DLA-LS) is established. Under the direction and guidance of the Assistant Director, Office of Policy and Plans, is responsible for:

1. Development, evaluation, and coordination of automated and manual logistics and administrative systems and procedures.

2. Serves as Data Strategist for the Agency and chairs the Automated Information Systems Review Board.

E. Responsibility for the Defense Regional Interservice Support (DRIS) Program is reassigned from the Policy and Plans Division to the Organization, Position Management and Military Manpower Division.

III. Administrative support for these organizations will be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
