I. Reference: DLA-LPO General Order No. 26-87, dated 22 December 1987.

II. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 7 April, 1988, subject: Reorganization of Defense Logistics Standard Systems Office (DLSSO).

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 11 May, 1988, the Defense Logistics Standard Systems Office (DLSSO) is realigned as follows:

A. The Distribution Standard Systems Branch and the Management Standard Systems Branch are retitled the Distribution Standard Systems Division and the Management Standard Systems Division, respectively.

B. The Programs and Technology Division is established as an element of DLSSO and is assigned responsibility for development and coordination of DoD/DLSSO policy, plans and programs for electronic data interchange (EDI), Modernization of Defense Logistics Standard Systems (MODELS), and other various Office of the Secretary of Defense taskings, including hardware/software requirements necessary to conduct translations, maintenance and telecommunications interfaces between user installations.

IV. The Commander, DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC), will continue to provide administrative and logistical support to DLSSO.
