
I. Authority: Assistant Secretary of Defense (Production and Logistics) memorandum, dated 21 November 1988, subject: Reorganization of Management Support Activities.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 4 December 1988, the Defense Regulatory Reform Office (DFRRO), an OSD Management Support Activity with program and performance accountability to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Procurement) (DASD(P)), is redesignated the Defense Procurement Support Office (DPSO) as an unstructured MSA. DPSO remains under the program and performance accountability of the DASD(P). The DPSO mission is to provide analysis, development, and recommendations on acquisition and procurement policy, procedures, and practices to assure maximum effectiveness in DoD procurement programs.

III. General Order 16-87, dated 19 November 1987, is rescinded.

IV. Administrative and logistics support for DPSO will be controlled through the P&L Management Support Center (MSC) and be provided by the Commander, DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
