GENERAL ORDER  
NO. 13-89

I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-L Staff Summary Sheet, dated 19 July 1989, subject: Reorganization of the Office of Telecommunications and Information Systems (DLA-Z).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 23 July 1989 the Office of Telecommunications and Information Systems (DLA-Z) is realigned as follows:

a. The Office of Telecommunications and Information Systems (DLA-Z) is redesignated as the Office of Information Systems and Technology (DLA-Z).

b. The following organizations are disestablished:

1. The DLA ADP/T Research and Development and Strategic Technology Office (DRDO). (MSA)
2. The DLA Computer Aided Logistics Management Support Office (DCLSO). (MSA)
3. The DLA Technical ADP/T Modernization Program Office (DLA-ZM).
4. DLA Logistics Systems Modernization Office (DLSMO). (MSA)
5. AIS Development and Control Division (DLA-ZS).
6. Technology Division (DLA-ZW).
7. Logistics Requirements and Systems Integration Division (DLA-LS).

c. The following organizations are established:


1. The DLA Systems Integration Division (DLA-ZI). The Division integrates Automated Information Systems (AIS) and Telecommunications Systems for DLA. Performs ADP/T standards, and administers information engineering and related programs for DLA.
2. The DLA Systems Management Office (DSMO) as a HQ DLA MSA reporting to DLA-Z. The MSA performs program/project management for all ADP/T initiatives within DLA to include new systems, major modifications and systems change requests, and is the single interface point for DLA PSEs on all matters regarding AIS and Telecommunications.
3. The DLA Systems Operations Division (DLA-ZO). The Division is the single point of contact at HQ DLA for the Offices of Information Services (OIS) and the Information Processing Centers (IPC). The Division develops and maintains methodology for performing the ADP/T operations mission.
4. DLA Information Resources Management Division (DLA-ZR). The Division administers the IRM program to include resources management, IRM reviews, IRM Policy, IRM procedures, IRM oversight and IRM planning for the Agency.

- d. The following organizations are reassigned:
1. The Defense Automatic Addressing System Office Dayton, OH/Tracy, CA (DAASO) from DLA-ZS to DLA-Z.
  2. SAMMS Immediate Improvement Initiative (I3) from the Directorate of Supply Operations (DLA-O) to DSMO.
  3. Program Manager for DLSC Automated Data Processing Systems Modernization Program (DASMP) from DLA-D to DSMO.
  4. DAAS ADPE Replacement and Modernization Program (DARP) from DLA-Z to DSMO.

III. General Orders Nos. 8-88, 5 April 1988; 10-87, 26 August 1987; 27-86, 20 October 1987; 27-86, 20 October 1986; 15-86, 11 April 1986; and 44-85 23 December 1985 are rescinded.

IV. Administrative support for DACO and DSMO will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center.
