I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-L Staff Summary Sheet, dated 25 June 1991  
subject: Realignment of the DLA Quality Assurance Management Support Office,  
Marietta, GA

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 1 September 1991, the DLA Quality Assurance Management Support Office (DQMSO), Marietta, GA, is disestablished, and the Technical Development and Training Branch (DLA-QET), Program and Systems Management Division (DLA-QP), Directorate of Quality Assurance Headquarters, Defense Logistics Agency (HQ DLA) is established. The mission and functions of the Technical Development, Engineering and Maintenance Branch (DQMSO-T) less the following are transferred to DLA-QET:

A. Developing policies, procedures, and exercising staff supervision over technical maintenance and engineering programs including:

1. Contractor packaging and QA support to industrial property management transferred to Branch B (DLA-QPB), Product Quality Management Division (DLA-QP), HQ DLA-Q.


2. New production of aircraft and engines, and overhaul and maintenance of major items and components transferred to Branch A (DLA-QPA), Product Quality Management Division (DLA-QP), HQ DLA-Q.

B. The Engineering Management Branch (DLA-QEL), Quality Engineer and Computer Software Division (DLA-QE), HQ DLA-Q, assumes former DQMSO-T functions relative to developing policies, procedures, and exercising staff supervision over technical maintenance and engineering programs including contractor reliability and maintainability.

C. The former DQMSO-T function of validating and developing appropriate blocks of instruction relative to quality assurance for inclusion in the curriculum of selected technical and service schools is vested in each assigned Subject Matter Expert (SME) within the respective DLA-Q division.

III. Administrative support will be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center, Cameron Station, Alexandria, Virginia.
