I. AUTHORITY. DCMC-D approval of Staff Summary Sheet dated 6 March 1992, subject: Contract Management of Overseas Defense Fuel Supply Center (DFSC) Contracts.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 12 April 1992, cognizance of the contract management functions of Defense Fuel Region (DFR) South, DFR Europe, DFR Mid East, and DFR Pacific is transferred as is, where is, to the Defense Contract Administration Command International (DCMCI). These DFRs will continue to provide support through Interservice Support Agreements (ISAs) until 1 October 1992, at which time DCMCI will assume full quality assurance responsibilities for direct delivery and "bulk" fuels contracts overseas.

III. Contract Administration Services (CAS) cognizance of Alaska will transfer from the Defense Contract Management District West (DCMDW), Defense Contract Management Area Operations (DCMAO) Seattle, to DCMCI, effective 12 April 1992.

IV. Personnel and payroll records will be transferred in accordance with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service scheduling for staffing identified at the enclosure.

V. Administrative support will continue to be provided as currently configured.
