GENERAL ORDER
NO. 43-92

I. Authority: Approval by the Assistant Director, Office of Policy and Plans, of the realignment of the Office of Information Systems and Technology (DLA-Z).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 30 August 1992, DLA-Z organizations are realigned as follows:

A. The Consolidation Program Management Office (DLA-ZC) is renamed the Defense Electronic Commerce/Electronic Data Interchange (EC/EDI) Joint Program Management Office. DLA-ZC will retain the personnel previously assigned to the former Consolidation Program Management Office, the former DLA-ZC.


B. All the functions of the Consolidation Program Management Office (the former DLA-ZC), except those relating to "Fee for Service," are realigned to the Site Administration Branch (DLA-ZOS). The "Fee for Service" functions are transferred to the Resources Management Branch (DLA-ZRM).

C. The EC/EDI Branch (DLA-ZIE) is disestablished and its personnel and functions merged into the renamed DLA-ZC.

III. This realignment is in response to a DoD tasking to establish a Joint program office to oversee the implementation of the EC/EDI and the Protection of Logistics Unclassified/Sensitive Systems (PLUS).

IV. Administrative support will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center.
