GENERAL ORDER  
NO. 44-92

I. **AUTHORITY:** Approval by the Assistant Director, Office of Policy and Plans, of the realignment of the Office of Comptroller (DLA-C).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective immediately, the Office of Comptroller is realigned as follows:

A. The DLA Productivity Demonstration Projects Office (DPDPO) and the DLA Commercial Activity Program Office (DCAPO) are disestablished.

B. The Revolving Fund Budget Division (DLA-CR) is disestablished.

C. The Accounting and Finance Division (DLA-CF), the DLA Modernization of Payments Project Management Office (DMPMO), and the DLA Financial Systems Evaluation Office (DFSEO) are disestablished as a result of the transfer of finance and accounting service functions to the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS).

D. The Program/Budget Division (DLA-CB) is realigned to redesignate its subordinate elements as the Supply Operations Branch (DLA-CBR), the Depot Operations Branch (DLA-CED), the Contract Administration Branch (DLA-CBC), and the Service Centers Branch (DLA-CBS). The Capital Investment Branch (DLA-CBI) is also established, with responsibility for budget and review of capital investment requirements.

E. The Internal Review Division (DLA-CI) is realigned as an unstructured organization. The Internal Review Policy and Analysis Branch (DLA-CIR) and the Oversight and Analysis Branch (DLA-CIO) are disestablished.

F. The Management Improvement Division (DLA-CE) is established, with responsibility for productivity policy and demonstration projects, the DLA Commercial Activity Program, the DLA work measurement program, and resource management reviews. The division will consist of two branches: the Process Management Branch (DLA-CEP), and the Measurement and Review Branch (DLA-CER).

G. The Financial Systems and Control Division (DLA-CX) is established, with responsibility for pricing and financing policies, procedures, and requirements, and presentation of the coordinated DLA Program Objectives Memorandum (POM). The subordinate elements of this division are established as: the Accounting Requirements Branch (DLA-CXA), the Financial Controls Branch (DLA-CXC), the Business Funds Financing Branch (DLA-CXF), the Financial Planning and Policy Branch (DLA-CXP), and the Business Systems Requirements Branch (DLA-CXS).
