GENERAL ORDER
NO. 5-93

I. AUTHORITY:

- A. By order of the Director, Defense Logistics Agency, 9 December 1992.
- B. Approval of the Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Production and Logistics), 2 February 1993.
- C. Approval of the Director, Administration and Management, Office of the Secretary of Defense 12 February 1993.
- D. Department of Defense Directive 5105.22, Defense Logistics Agency.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 8 March 1993, HQ DLA is organized as follows:

A. Establish a Principal Deputy to the Director, DLA, who will act for and advise the Director, DLA, in the direction, control, and management of the Agency mission. The Principal Deputy Director will also exercise command and control of the Joint Logistics Systems Center (JLSC).

B. Establish a Deputy Director (Materiel Management) reporting to the Director and Principal Deputy Director, DLA, responsible for supply management and distribution and associated planning, including command and control of the Inventory Control Points (ICPs), Defense Distribution Depots, Defense Logistics Services Center (DLSC), Defense National Stockpile Center (DNSC), Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service (DRMS), Defense Distribution Systems Center (DDSC), and DLA Operations Support Office (DOSO).

1. Establish an Executive Directorate (Supply Management) under the Deputy Director (Materiel Management).

2. Establish an Executive Directorate (Distribution) under the Deputy Director (Materiel Management).

3. Establish the Transportation Office under the Deputy Director (Materiel Management).

4. Establish the Readiness Support Office under the Deputy Director (Materiel Management).

C. Establish a Deputy Director (Corporate Administration) reporting to the Director and Principal Deputy Director, DLA, responsible for corporate policy and planning integration, operations research and economic analysis, contingency and wartime planning, corporate mission planning, international logistics, corporate marketing, human resources, common support services including installation services, environmental and safety policy, information management, congressional and public affairs; and exercises command and control of DLA Europe (DEUR), DLA Pacific (DPAC), and the DLA Administrative Support Center(s) (DASCs).

1. Establish an Executive Directorate (Human Resources) under the Deputy Director (Corporate Administration).

2. Establish an Executive Directorate (Plans and Policy Integration) under the Deputy Director (Corporate Administration).

3. Establish the following additional organizations under the Deputy Director (Corporate Administration): Project Office, Environmental and Safety Policy Office, Office of Information, and Special Staff which includes Congressional Affairs, Public Affairs, Command Security, Corporate Marketing,

Installation Services, Corporate Performance, and Equal Employment Opportunity.

D. Establish a Deputy Director (Acquisition), who also serves as Commander, Defense Contract Management Command, reporting to the Director and Principal Deputy Director, DLA, responsible for contract management and procurement and associated planning, including command and control of the Defense Contract Management Districts (DCMDs).

1. Establish an Executive Directorate (Contract Management) under the Deputy Director (Acquisition).

2. Establish an Executive Directorate (Procurement) under the Deputy Director (Acquisition).

3. Establish an Acquisition Office under the Deputy Director (Acquisition).

4. Establish a Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization Advisor under the Deputy Director (Acquisition).


E. Establish the General Counsel reporting to the Director and Principal Deputy Director, DLA, who will be responsible for legal advice and services for the Agency.

F. Establish the Chief Financial Officer, reporting to the Director and Principal Deputy Director, DLA, who will be responsible for financial management for the Agency.

G. The Director, DLA, Principal Deputy, three Deputy Directors, Chief Financial Officer, and General Counsel will comprise the Executive Team for the Agency.

H. The Director, DLA, the Principal Deputy, the three Deputy Directors, the Chief Financial Officer, the General Counsel, and the six Executive Directors will comprise the Management Team for the Agency.

III. Administrative support will be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center.
