GENERAL ORDER
NO. 10-98

I. AUTHORITY: Approval of the Director, Defense Logistics Agency (DLA). This General Order is reissued to correct paragraph VI of HQ DLA General Order 7-98, dated March 3, 1998, which is hereby rescinded.


III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective on a date to be determined, the Commander, DLA Pacific (DPAC), will be located at Taegu, Korea. The Deputy Commander, DPAC, will remain at Camp Smith, Hawaii.

IV. The Commanders of DLA Pacific (DPAC) and DLA Europe (DEUR) provide a single DLA focal point to their respective Commander in Chiefs (CINCs) and Service Components for overall DLA liaison and logistical planning relating to DLA supplies and services support. As such, DPAC and DEUR have tasking lines of authority over Secondary Level Field Activities (SLFAs) in their respective theaters when resolving issues that impact the CINC or Service Component. SLFA Commanders retain their current functional chain of command with their PLFAs, with DEUR and DPAC providing additional letter input on the fitness reports (FITREPS) of SLFA Commanders in-theater. DEUR and DPAC will act as HQ DLA's singular focal point for all DLA issues in-theater.

V. Tertiary Level Field Activities of the Defense Automated Printing and Support Center (DAPSC) will be established in both theaters. These DAPSC centers, the DLA Administrative Support Center, Pacific (DASC-FP) and the DLA Administrative Support Center, Europe (DASC-FE), will provide on a fee-for-service basis, common support services to DLA activities in the Pacific and Europe theaters, respectively.

VI. Memoranda of Agreement (MOAs) between DLA and the respective CINCs specify reporting relationships in peacetime and contingency operations. Policies, procedures, and guidelines will be addressed in a forthcoming policy letter.
