**GENERAL ORDER

**I. AUTHORITY: Program Budget Decision 299, dated December 1, 1997, subject: Defense-Wide Programs and Program Budget Decision 299C, dated December 19, 1997, subject: Defense-Wide Programs.**

**II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective October 11, 1998, Executive Agent responsibility for the Rapid Acquisition of Manufactured Parts (RAMP) program is transferred to DLA from the Department of the Navy. RAMP is established under the supervision, direction, and operational control of the Commander, Defense Logistics Support Command. The RAMP program will reside in the previously established Strategic Business Development and Implementation Group (DLSC-PRT) and have an organization symbol of DLSC-PRT.**

**III. The RAMP mission is to develop methods to reduce the acquisition and manufacturing lead times for parts in limited supply. Its objective is to develop the capability to more quickly and efficiently manufacture low-volume, hard-to-obtain parts.**

**IV. The Defense Automated Printing and Support Center (DAPSC) will provide administrative support.**
