I. **AUTHORITY:** Approval of the Director, Defense Logistics Agency (DLA).

II. **REFERENCE:** HQ DLA General Order No. 8-00, dated September 11, 2000.

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective April 1, 2001, Joint Reserve Forces (JRF), J-9, is established as the principal staff advisor to the Director, DLA in development and application of JRF support and readiness policies and programs. Develops and administers plans, policies, and procedures for the Director in coordination with the other HQ mission areas and field activities, for support of Military Services, Unified Commanders in Chief, other Combat Support Agencies, and designated Federal agencies during contingencies, whether humanitarian, Operations Other Than War, or Major Theater War. DLA Reserve Readiness (J-348) is disestablished and its resources transferred to J-9. J-9 will consist of the following two divisions:

A. Reserve Readiness Division, J-91. The Reserve Readiness Division manages, coordinates, and facilitates the JRF program for all matters pertaining to manpower, personnel, readiness, administration, and budget. The Division is the conduit for all DLA reserve administrative, manpower, recruitment, and personnel matters among the Services and HQ DLA, field activities, Joint Reserve Team Leaders (JTL), and Reserve Coordinators.

B. Reserve Mobilization Division, J-92. The Reserve Mobilization Division (collocated with J-341, Contingency Plans and Operations Division) manages, coordinates, and facilitates the JRF mobilization program. This Division is the conduit for all DLA Reserve mobilization matters (e.g., deployment team manning, equipping, training, and planning) among the Services, HQ DLA, field activities, Joint Reserve Forces Leadership Council (JRFLC), JTLs, and Reserve Coordinators.

IV. Administrative services and support will be provided by HQ DLA organizations, as appropriate.
