I. **AUTHORITY:** Approval of the Director, Defense Logistics Agency (DLA).

II. **REFERENCE:** HQ DLA General Order No. 6-00, dated May 31, 2000.

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective June 1, 2001, the DLA Logistics Operations, J-3, branches formerly known as Readiness Assessment (J-342) and Weapon Systems Analysis (J-346) are merged. The new office will be titled Readiness Assessment and Weapon Systems Analysis, J-342. This office is responsible for conducting all readiness assessments and analyses on DLA weapon system support. Specific responsibilities are as follows:

A. Responsible for the development, implementation, and maintenance of the Integrated Consumable Item Support (ICIS) Model, which provides support to the Joint Chiefs of Staff (JCS) Exercise Program.

B. Serves as the functional lead for the Weapon System Support Program (WSSP), which provides research and analysis capability for the Military Services, Military Service Teams, International Logistics, Customer Surveys, and Contractor Logistics Support (CLS) initiatives. Also responsible for providing support to DLA's Tiered Investment Strategy and working on functional requirements tied to weapon system coding and system interfaces.

C. Manages HQ DLA Defense Management Council Performance Contract on all Military Service Weapon System Support areas.

D. Manages HQ DLA Lead Center Core Metrics with DLA Inventory Control Points (ICP) and ICP Weapon System Support Managers (WSSM). Runs and uploads monthly Weapon System Summaries and Reports for HQ DLA and Primary Level Field Activity personnel, Customer Service Representatives, and ICP WSSMs.

E. Manages DLA input to the Joint Monthly Readiness Report (JMRR) that goes to the Joint Staff and coordinates DLA input to the DoD Quarterly Readiness Report to Congress (QRRC).

F. Serves as the J-3 proponent for the Integrated Data Environment (IDE) and is the chairman of the IDE User's Group.

G. Serves as the HQ DLA lead for the Quadrennial Defense Review (QDR), under the Sustainment, Strategic Mobility & Infrastructure (SSMI) Panel.

H. Leads Agency effort to standardize Emergency Supply Operation Centers (ESOC) at DLA Supply Centers.
