**GENERAL ORDER

I. AUTHORITY: Approval of the Director, Defense Logistics Agency (DLA).

II. REFERENCES:

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective July 14, 2002, the changes in Logistics Operations (J-3) organizational alignment are as stated below:

A. The Defense Standardization Program Office (J-330) is realigned from J-33 to (J-307) for direct report to J-3.

B. The Logistics Policy and Acquisition Management Directorate (J-33) is retitled Acquisition, Technical, and Supply Directorate and includes the following organizations: Acquisition Division (J-331), Supply Management Division (J-332), Technical and Quality Policy Division (J-334), and Industrial Capabilities Division (J-339). The following organizations are disestablished and their missions, functions, and resources have been realigned to the newly established J-33 organizations: Technical Services Division (J-334), Acquisition Programs Division (J-335), Contract Policy Division (J-336), Procurement Integrity and Pricing Division (J-337), Supplier Assessment and Capabilities Division (J-338), and Research and Development Enterprise Division (J-339). The Disposition Management Division (J-331) and the Distribution Management Division (J-333) are disestablished. The missions, functions, and related resources of J-331 and J-333 are realigned to the newly established Distribution and Reutilization Policy Directorate (J-37).

C. The Readiness and Customer Support Directorate (J-34) is reorganized as follows: The Weapons Systems Support Branch (J-3812) is disestablished and its mission, functions, and resources are realigned to the existing Readiness Assessment and Weapons System Analysis Division (J-342). The commodity-related mission, functions and resources of the Business Support Branch (J-3821) are realigned to the existing Readiness Assessment and Weapons System Analysis Division (J-342). The Critical Infrastructure Protection Division (J-349) is established and being formally documented in these General Orders.

D. The Distribution and Reutilization Policy Directorate (J-37) is established. The Business Development and Supply Chain Integration Division (J-371) is established. The missions, functions, and related resources of the Business Development and Supply Chain Integration Division (J-381), the Tailored Logistics/Distribution Initiatives Branch (J-3811), and the Initiative Coordination and Integration Branch (J-3813)

are realigned to Business Development and Supply Chain Integration Division (J-371). The Disposition Management Division (J-372) and the Distribution Management Division (J-373) are established. The missions, functions, and related resources of J-331 and J-333 are realigned to the Disposition Management Division (J-372) and the Distribution Management Division (J-373) respectively. The Competitive Sourcing Division (J-374) is established. The Competitive Sourcing Branch (J-3824) is disestablished, and its missions, functions, and related resources are realigned to the Competitive Sourcing Division (J-374).

E. The Business Management Directorate (J-38) is realigned as follows: The Business Development and Supply Chain Integration Division (J-381) and the Business Operation Division (J-382) are disestablished. The Resource Requirements and Assessments Division (J-381) and the Planning, Assessment, and Integration Division (J-382) are established. The mission, functions, and resources of the Business Development and Supply Chain Integration Division are realigned to J-37 and J-34 as indicated above. The Competitive Sourcing Branch (J-3824) is disestablished and its mission, functions, and resources realigned to J-37 as indicated above.

IV. Administrative services and support will be provided by HQ DLA organizations as appropriate.
