I. AUTHORITY: Approval of the Director, Defense Logistics Agency

II. REFERENCE: The DLA Correspondence Guide, dated November 2000

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective immediately, six existing DLA organizations are designated as DLA Lead Centers. A DLA Lead Center manages the supply chain for a designated customer segment. Designation as a DLA Lead Center does not change the name or organizational structure of the DLA activity. The use of the terms Primary Level Field Activity (PLFA), Secondary Level Field Activity (SLFA), and Tertiary Level Field Activity (TLFA) are no longer approved for use in DLA. All field activities of DLA will be identified as DLA field activities (FA), with six identified as DLA Lead Centers. DLA Europe (DLA-E), DLA Pacific (DLA-P), Document Automation and Production Service (DAPS), Defense Logistics Information Service (DLIS), and Defense National Stockpile Center (DNSC) are DLA field activities. DLA's six Lead Centers are:

1. Defense Supply Center Columbus (DSCC)	Maritime/Land
2. Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (DSCP)	Troop Support
3. Defense Supply Center Richmond (DSCR)	Aviation
4. Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service (DRMS)	Reutilization
5. Defense Energy Support Center (DESC)	Energy
6. Defense Distribution Center (DDC)	Distribution

IV. Administrative services and support will not be affected by this General Order.
