A major subordinate command of Defense Logistics Agency, DLA Aviation manages the aviation demand and supply chain for much of the Defense Department. More than 4,300 DLA Aviation civilian and military personnel provide daily weapons systems and environmental logistics support to the defense aviation community and other federal customers.

Our employees are proud to work directly alongside warfighters at most of our 23 locations across the continental U.S. and – as of 2023 – at Kadena Air Base in Okinawa, Japan. Among our unique services, we also operate the only U.S. government industrial plant equipment facility, located in Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania.

DLA Aviation supports more than 13,500 joint military aircraft, 450 intercontinental ballistic missiles and a host of other weapons systems. The U.S. military relies on us to serve as the integrated aviation material manager for roughly 1.8 million national stock number items, providing direct support through weapons systems management, industrial retail supply and strategic acquisition support operations.

In fiscal year 2023, we continued a track record of proven performance with \$3.79 billion in sales, working closely with more than 3,200 suppliers as we processed and fulfilled 3.7 million orders from 12,678 supported customers.

We take great pride in our pivotal role providing targeted solutions and full-spectrum logistics support to our Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force and Space Force as part of the Nation's Combat Logistics Support Agency.
