Mapping Customer Operations (MCO) is responsible for the supply management of approximately 90,000 National Stock Numbers in four federal supply classes—7641 (Aeronautical), 7642 (Hydrographic), 7643 (Topographic), and 7644 (Digital CD/DVD). MCO also manages special programs including Fleet Allowance, Flight Information Publications, and War Reserve.

While this is “nice to know” information, MCO understands that most of you just want to order and receive mapping products with the least amount of hassle. We have no control over some of the hurdles you face, such as AMPS, but know that MCO is always available to help you through the process. The contact list on the last page of this newsletter is probably more important than anything else in this publication. Never hesitate to give MCO a call or send an email. ### DLA Map Catalog Version 2.0

The DLA Map Catalog Team is pleased to announce that version 2.0 of the standalone / CD-ROM DLA Map Catalog has been released. This catalog has a different look and some new features, but retains all of the tools that you have used in the past. Some of these new improvements include:

- A more Interactive Table of Contents that allows for map product layers to be toggled on and off with a click of a mouse button. Also, custom labels can be displayed with a few mouse clicks on the Table of Contents.
- The Main Map Display allows you to pan across the Pacific Ocean, allowing for the generation of seamless routes and product searches within that portion of the world.
- A streamlined Search Results window allows you to specify the quantity and priority for each product added to the shopping cart without the extra window that appears in the current version (1.8).

These and many more improvements are included in version 2.0 map catalog release. A “What’s New” video will be available to illustrate some of these new features. The previous version (1.8) of the map catalog will no longer be updated. The data updates available via email subscription or through the download page in DOD EMALL will continue to work for those that need to continue using an older version of the catalog.

## New Map / Chart Accounts

To obtain mapping products from MCO, customers must first register in the Account Management & Provisioning System (AMPS) at <https://amps.dla.mil/> and request a role within the Mapping Enterprise Business System (MEBS). Go to <https://amps.dla.mil/> to register and click on the link to request a role. You will receive email confirmation once approved. To access your account, log in to AMPS and select your MEBS role.

A couple of registration hints—you will be asked to identify your supervisor, and security officer. These individuals will receive AMPS-generated emails throughout the registration process and must be answered for the account to be approved. You will also need to know your last Information Assurance training date. One last item you will need is your DODAAC, which will be your map/chart account number. Please keep all AMPS/MEBS related emails, especially the one containing your SAAR number. Changing account custodians on an existing account is done in much the same way as opening a new account. New custodians must also register in AMPS using the map account DODAAC. As always, if you have any questions give us a call (800 826-0342).

## DLA Map Catalog

The DLA Map Catalog allows customers to order Aero, Hydro, Topo, and Digital (CD/DVD) products needed for their particular missions. Customers who order geospatial products through DLA must have the following:

- A valid DODAAC.
- Current map/chart account with MCO.
- DLA Map Catalog CD or online version.
- A WEBREQ or DOD EMALL account.

There are two CD versions of the Map Catalog available, as described below:

CD Versions-

1. The 'Limited Distribution' gray CD is reserved for military and government agencies which possess access to limited distribution data. The disk is Navy/Marine Corps Intranet (NMCI) compatible. A new version is released every six months. This version is also downloadable via DoD EMALL.
2. The classified red CD is reserved for military and government entities that have access to classified data. A new version is released every six months.

DLA Map Catalog CD-ROM Data Files are now available in DoD EMALL. Users can now use DoD EMALL to download the data files used to update/maintain the CD-ROM DLA Map Catalog. Simply log into DoD EMALL and click on the "DLA Map Catalog" link at the bottom of the main page to access the current edition of the CD-ROM DLA Map Catalog application in zip file format and the four (5) product data zip files: Aero, Hydro, Digital, Topo and USGS. Follow the download instructions associated with the file(s) you need to download. The data zip files will be updated weekly. The DLA Map Catalog program file will be updated every six (6) months or as needed. Subscription Service is now available for DLA Map Catalog Data Files. Users can now subscribe to receive the DLA Map Catalog data files via E-mail. These data files are required to maintain and update the DLA Map Catalog CD-ROM between releases. To receive these files weekly or monthly, submit an E-mail to the DLA Map Catalog Team at: [DLAMCUC@dlamcuc.dla.mil](mailto:DLAMCUC@dlamcuc.dla.mil) with a list of the data file (s) requested (Digital, Aero, Hydro, Topo, USGS) and how often you would like to be notified (weekly, monthly).

## How to Order Maps?

There are a few ways that you place orders for your mapping products. The two most common ways are to submit them electronically using [WEBREQ](#) or [DOD EMALL](#). Orders are submitted in MILSTRIP format and are routed to MCO. WEBREQ is DLA's legacy system for ordering mapping products. Orders can be entered manually, but most customers use the DLA Map Catalog to build the order and then upload the text file into WEBREQ. DOD EMALL, the newer of the two systems has the ability to upload up to 10,000 items at a time and the DLA Map Catalog is available for download as mentioned above. Order tracking is available regardless of which system you use, as long as you have your document number available. \*Army units in the CENTCOM AOR must use SARSS, IAW Army policy.

### **Crisis Ordering:**

MCO can assist with any emergency requests due to crisis situations, short-notice deployments or any other unexpected development.
