What is LMS?

The DLA LMS is a commercial off-the-shelf software package that provides capabilities for employees and supervisors to better manage the entire spectrum of learning from planning to learning event execution within a single environment.

Students can:

- Browse courses
- · View their My Learning Assignments
- Check their curriculum status
- · Review their Learning History
- View their profile
- · Run reports pertaining to self



Supervisors can view the same items as students and also:

- · View subordinates' My Learning Assignments and Learning History
- Run reports on subordinates
- Receive notifications of overdue learning events for subordinates
- Receive learning event notifications for subordinates

This takes you to the LMS page. Select **Access the DLA Learning Management** System (LMS).


First Time Users

DLA LMS automatically recognizes you by your Common Access Card (CAC). There are no logon IDs or passwords to remember.


LMS is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.




Can I Update my Profile?
