4. APPROVED CHANGE(S):

a. <u>Brief Overview of Change</u>: Army requires use of the purpose code in the DLMS 947I Dual Inventory Adjustment for Supply Conditions Code Change (947I with 2/W1901/200 Quantity Status Adjustment Reason Code AC—Condition Code Change). This will allow SCC changes for materiel identified or segregated by purpose code.

The Army requests this change for intra-Army use, primarily to facilitate maintaining stock with a purpose code identifier in Army Logistics Modernization Program (LMP), Global Combat Support System (GCSS), and in systems owned by third party vendors who do business with the Army. All other components may adopt this capability as a DLMS enhancement for intracomponent usage.

b. Background:

- (1) Army LMP maintains inventory within GCSS Army and third party vendor systems. LMP stratifies this inventory by purpose code, ownership code, project code, condition code and owner RIC.
- (2) The purpose code is an important element used by LMP to maintain stock batches. DLMS transactions like 846R Location Reconciliation and some uses of the 947I Inventory Adjustment Increase or Decrease have established procedures that allow use of purpose code. There are no existing procedures to use the purpose code when the DLMS Implementation Convention (IC) 947I is a Dual Inventory Adjustment for Supply Conditions Code Change (947I with 2/W1901/200 Quantity Status Adjustment Reason Code AC Condition Code Change). LMP uses the DLMS 947I to change condition codes of inventory between LMP, as the inventory control point, and GCSS Army and third party vendors as the storage locations.
- (3) LMP uses both ownership codes and purpose codes to create and maintain materiel batches and to identify the correct batch of materiel for which the condition code change is requested. ADC 1149 (Reference 3.b.) approved the use of the ownership code when the DLMS 947I is used for a dual inventory adjustment—Supply Condition Code change, but not the usage of the purpose code. The purpose code is essential for LMP to properly stratify stock.

c. Approved Change in Detail:

- (1) Revise DLMS 947I Inventory Adjustment Implementation Convention and authorize the use of purpose code in a dual inventory adjustment when changing the condition of an item (2/W1901/0200 code AC) segregated by purpose code.
- (2) Update DLMS note for 2/LQ01/1000–99 Purpose Code to enable the Army capability for SCC changes for materiel identified or segregated by purpose code.
- (3) This change will ensure that LMP can maintain, identify, and reconcile LMP stock identified with a purpose code. See the Enclosure.
 - (4) This change is an optional DLMS enhancement for non-Army systems.

- d. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 Manuals: None.
- e. Approved Transaction Flow: There are no changes to the transaction flow.
- **f.** Alternatives: There are no alternatives.
- **5. REASON FOR CHANGE:** This change is required to support accountability of stock stratified by purpose code maintained at other storage locations and in trading partner systems.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

- **a.** Advantages: Allowing the use of the purpose code with dual inventory adjustment (SCC) will help maintain, identify, and reconcile the stock stratified to a purpose code at LMP with third party vendor systems, making available an accurate accounting of Program-owned inventory along with inventory value.
 - b. **Disadvantages**: None.

7. ASSUMPTIONS USED OR WILL BE USED IN THE CHANGE OR NEW DEVELOPMENT:

- **a.** Army LMP is already programmed to receive and transmit purpose code with the DLMS 947I Dual Inventory Adjustment for Supply Conditions Code Change (947I with 2/W1901/200 Quantity Status Adjustment Code AC). The only update required should be DAAS mapping for the 947I.
- **b.** This change does not affect the legacy Document Identifier Code DAC Inventory Adjustment–Dual (Condition Transfer). The purpose code is not identified in a legacy DAC.
