Revision to Reject Advice Code Definition in Support of WMS

3. APPROVED CHANGE:

- **a.** <u>Brief Overview of Change</u>: This change revises the definition of Reject Advice Code "AI" to include call/order number, contract line-item number (CLIN), and/or sub-contract line-item number (sub-CLIN).
- **b.** <u>Background</u>: DLA is in the process of migrating to a Systems Applications & Products (SAP)-based commercial out-of-the-box software to replace the Distribution Standard System (DSS). For the migration process, DLA wants to automate some of the existing manual transaction and further validate procedures and practices. This change will enhance automation of due-in violations processes, specifically, automatic rejection of DLMS 527D Due-in (legacy document identifier code DU), when data is missing or invalid, using the DLMS 824R Reject Advice transaction and the appropriate reject advice code.
- c. <u>Approved Change in Detail</u>: Revise the definition of the Reject Advice Code "AI" as shown in paragraph 4.d. DoD Components and DAAS may use Reject Code "AI" when a given DLMS 527D Prepositioned Materiel Receipt (PMR) contains an invalid PIIN/PIID, call/order number, CLIN, and/or sub CLIN (References 2.a. and 2.b.). The intent is to clarify the current definition and not to change its current use and/or business rules. When a DoD Component receives a DLMS 824 Reject Advice transaction with Reject Advice Code "AI," the expectation is to perform corrective actions and re-transmit.

- **d.** Revisions to Defense Logistics Manuals: Revise DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, Appendix 2.8 Reject Advice Codes as follows:
- Al Rejected. Procurement instrument identifier (PIID) (contract number), call/order number, contract line-item number (CLIN), and/or sub-CLIN is invalid or blank.
 - e. Approved Transaction Flow: No known changes to transaction flows.
 - f. Alternatives: N/A
- **4. REASON FOR CHANGE:** This revision eliminates the need to implement several reject codes to address all the components of the PIID when the original intent was to consolidate all into one.
- 5. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:
- **a.** Advantages: Standardizes procedures for communicating PMR violations back to the source system.
 - b. **Disadvantages**: None
- **6. ASSUMPTIONS USED OR WILL BE USED IN THE CHANGE OR NEW DEVELOPMENT:** ICP systems will be able to receive and understand the DLMS 824R Reject Advice transaction (legacy DIC DZG).
