# Approved Defense Logistics Management Change 1450 Administrative Update DLMS 846R Location Reconciliation Request Note - MFR

#### 2. REASON FOR CHANGE:

- **a.** <u>Bottom Line Up-Front</u>: This administrative change removes the Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) 846R Location Reconciliation Request transaction note located in segment REF02/140 for the lot/segment number. REF02/140 should contain the value related to the code in REF01/140. The note is misleading because lot/segment is not a code in the REF01/140.
- **b.** <u>Background</u>: The Defense Automated Addressing System (DAAS) implementation team identified a syntax error in the DLMS 846R Location Reconciliation Request transaction during a DAAS mapping review. The current DLMS note is incorrect because lot/segment is not a code in the REF01/140.

#### 3. CHANGE IN DETAIL:

- **a.** <u>Technical Details</u>: Remove the note for the DLMS 846R Location Reconciliation Request associated with REF01/140 for the lot/segment identifier.
- **b.** <u>Revised Transaction Flow</u>: No impact to the Location Reconciliation Request transaction process flow.
