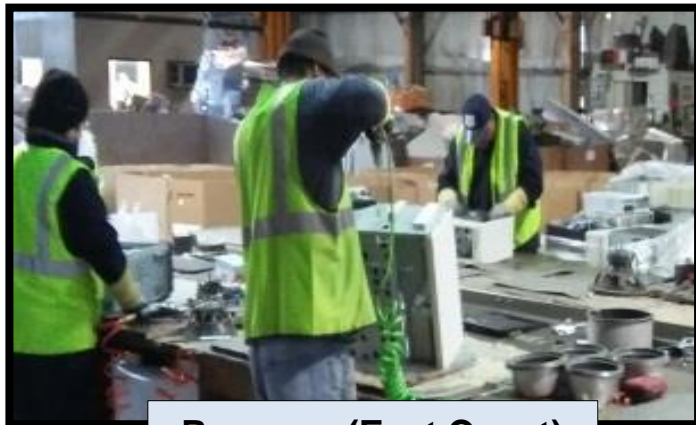

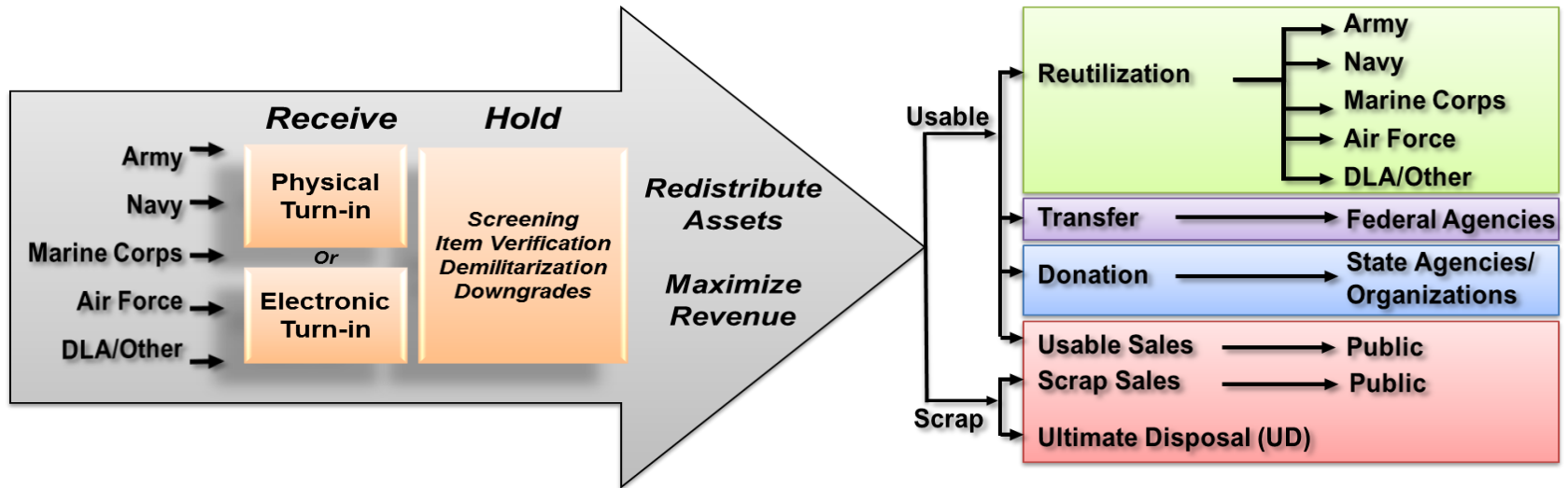
CV4 – ROLLING STOCK



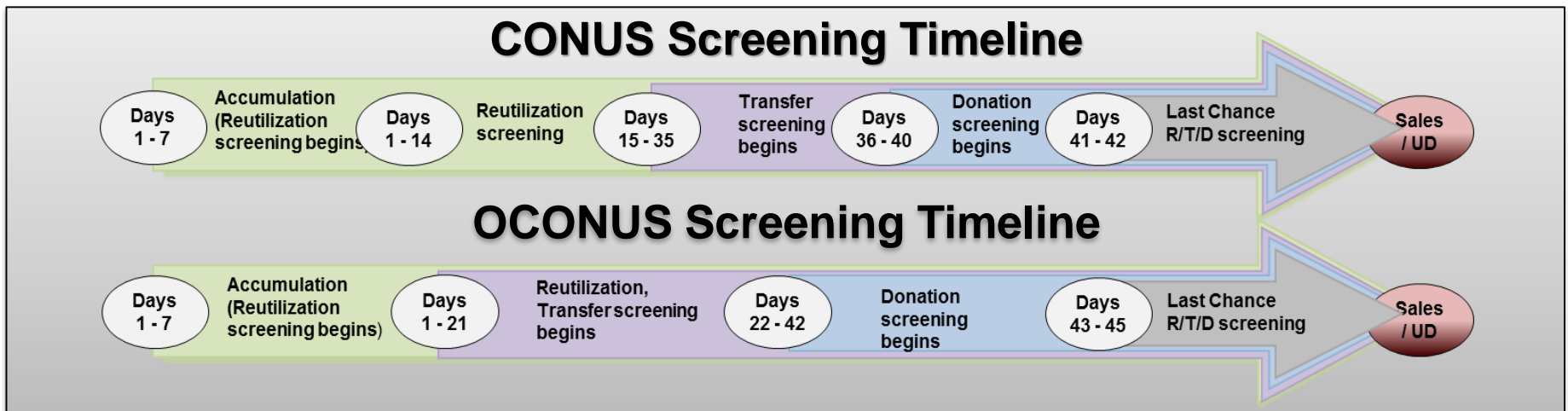

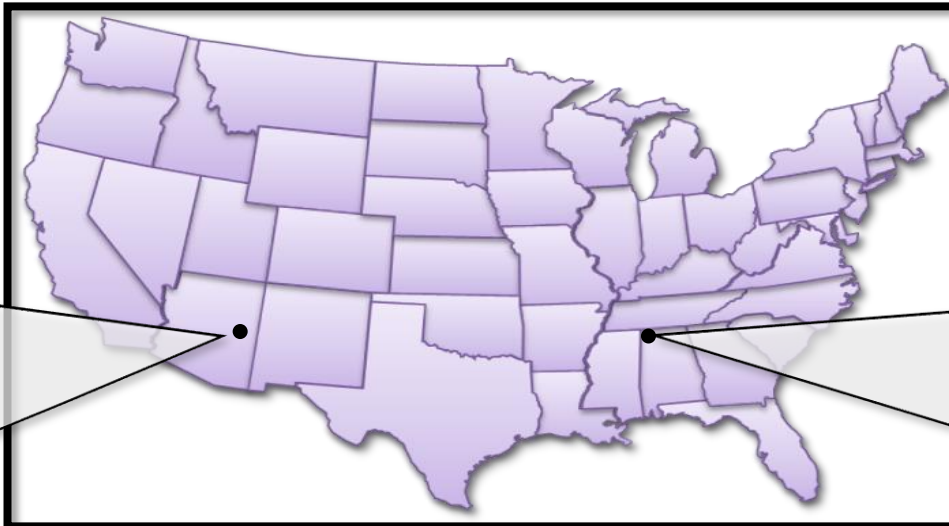


Precious Metals Recovery

Hazardous Waste Disposal

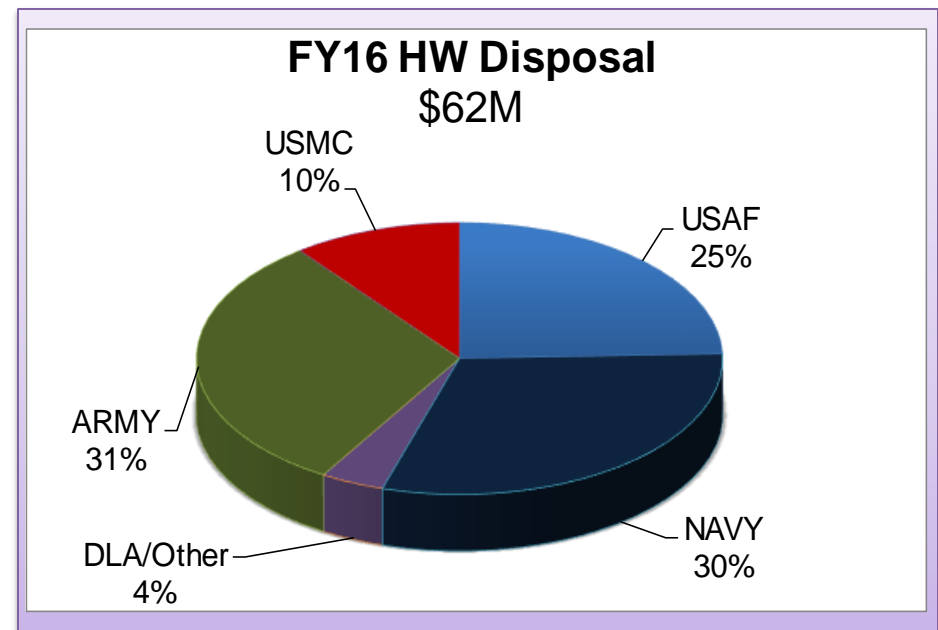
DLA's Role

- Assumes worldwide disposal responsibility for all DoD Hazardous Property
- Disposition Services is DLA's implementing activity

Hazardous Waste Disposal Profile – FY16

HW Contracts

- 75 contracts worldwide
 - Servicing over 2,100 military customers
 - 211M pounds shipped off-site (\$52M)
 - Recycled, Burned or Buried
 - Contractors provide \$10M worth of on-site HW services
 - Analysis, Collection, Storage, etc.
- Ensure Contractor Compliance
 - Vetting of qualified transporters/facilities
 - Pre-award and post-award
