United States Navy Supply Corps Cmdr. Brian M. Johnson assumed command of DLA Distribution Yokosuka, Japan, in June 2014.

Johnson, a native of Hollywood, Fl., and earned his commission through Officer Candidate School in Pensacola, Fl. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Regents College and a Master of Business Administration from the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, Calif., where he was the recipient of the Naval Supply Systems Command Award for Academic Excellence in Management.

Afloat, he served as sales and wardroom officer, USS BELLEAU WOOD (LHA-3) where he served through the first ever large deck hull swap between an LHA and LHD; food service and aviation supply officer, USS ESSEX (LHD-2); and supply officer, USS JOHN S MCCAIN (DDG-56) where the ship earned two consecutive “Blue E’s” and the Battle Effectiveness “E” Award.
