United States Navy Supply Corps Cmdr. Troy C. Morse assumed command of DLA Distribution Pearl Harbor on May 16, 2014.

Morse is a native of Bel Air, Md., and a 1997 graduate of Virginia Tech, where he earned a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics. He was commissioned an ensign in the Navy through the Reserve Officer Training Corps.
