United States Marine Corps Col. Keith D. Reventlow assumed command of Defense Logistics Agency Distribution San Joaquin, Calif., on July 17, 2013.

Reventlow's most recent prior assignment was as the 2d Marine Logistics Group G3 Operations Officer for II Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Lejeune N.C.

Reventlow was born in New Rochelle, N.Y. and was raised in Newtown, Conn. He was commissioned a second lieutenant in 1990 via the Platoon Leaders Course following graduation from Western Connecticut State University with a Bachelor's of Arts degree in Political Science.

His key billet assignments include East Division chief, U.S. Transportation Command; team lead for Supply and Maintenance, Installations and Logistics Department, Headquarters U.S. Marine Corps; deputy senior advisor, 1st Iraqi Division, Habbaniyah, Iraq; logistics officer, 26th Marine Expeditionary Unit; logistics officer 6th Marine Regiment; instructor, Logistics Operations School; operations officer, MEU Service Support Group 26.

Reventlow has commanded at the company, battalion and regimental levels. He commanded Headquarters and Service Company then Alpha Company, 8th Motor Transport Battalion. As a Battalion commander he commanded Combat Logistics Battalion 13, including a seven-month deployment to the CENTCOM area of responsibility in 2009. Additionally, he served as the acting commander for Combat Logistics Regiment 17 for six months during 2007.

Reventlow's military education includes The Basic School; Motor Transport Officer Course; Combined Logistics Officer's Advance Course; Command and Staff College; Air War College; Joint Professional Military Education Phase II.
