





Mr. Kevin Taylor

Director, Defense Distribution Depot Cherry Point, N.C.

Kevin Taylor became the director of Defense Distribution Depot, Cherry Point, N.C., or DDCN, in June 2009.

Taylor has more than 20 years of logistical experience with the Department of Defense beginning his federal career in 1984 as a temporary worker at the Naval Aviation Depot, Cherry Point, N.C.

In 1985, Taylor was selected for a permanent position in the Inventory Department, Supply Directorate, Cherry Point, N.C. Over the next few years he assumed positions of increasing responsibility and, in 1997, became the supervisor of the Inventory Integrity Division, Distribution Depot, Cherry Point, N.C.

In 1998, Taylor was a member of the team that prepared DDCN for the implementation of the Defense Standard System, or DSS, the warehouse management system used throughout the Department of Defense.

In 1999, Taylor was a cadre member for the A-76 competition and in 2000, was instrumental in writing the performance work statement for the preservation, packaging, packing, and marking satellite site of the local Naval Aviation Depot.

Taylor became deputy director of Defense Depot Cherry Point, N.C., in June 2000, where he served until being selected as DDCN's director. His responsibilities as deputy included directing the Continuing Government Activity and acting as the Contracting Officer's Representative. In 2001, at the conclusion of A-76 competition, it was determined that DDCN would be outsourced to a commercial activity. Taylor worked closely with the Defense Distribution Center's Transition Team, DDC Contracting Office, DDC Personnel Office, DDCN employees, and the incoming contractor to assure a smooth transition from a government run activity to a fully contracted site.

Taylor holds a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from East Carolina University, Greenville, N.C. He is also the recipient of numerous special service, incentive, and unit awards.
