1. Protecting PII is *Everybody's* Business!

Good stewardship of personal information, or personally identifiably information (PII), requires us to be aware of and use appropriate safeguards when handling PII. Personal information or PII is "information about an individual maintained by DLA, including but not limited to, education, financial transactions, medical history, and criminal or employment history and information which can be used to distinguish or trace an individual's identity, such as their name, social security number, date and place of birth, mother's maiden name, biometric records, etc., including any other personal information which is linked or linkable to an individual."
