



Upgrades for the WebFLIS customer expected in July

Improvements are projected in August 2014 for Federal Logistics Information Web Search (WebFLIS)



Some of the enhancements your customers can expect:

- Changes to the main query screen to reduce scrolling
- Addition of searches for characteristics, bill of materials, and historical data
- Single and multi-search fields will gray-out when not available for use during a search
- Inclusion of proprietary item data
- Federal Item X-Reference (FIXR) functionality present (FIXR projected for decommission August 2014)
- Tab format for easy navigation
- Two new fields are added, Item Unique Identification Indicator and Company Name/Part Number, along with associated help definitions for all fields
- The new application will only be available by Common Access Card (CAC), External Certificate Authority (ECA), or Federal Bridge Card

Current registered users will need to reregister for user roles through the Account Management and Provisioning System (AMPS). AMPS is projected to be available in June 2014 for pre-registration.

Non-government users of WebFLIS will be able to request public Federal Logistics Information System (FLIS) data using the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) or by visiting the FOIA Reading Room (click [here](#)) via a searchable product called Public Logistics Data on Portable Media (PUB LOG) FLIS Search. We will provide a link to PUB LOG FLIS Search and instructions when it becomes available so users can become familiar with it prior to the transition of Public WebFLIS.

FED LOG subscription change in FY15



FED LOG Subscribers urged to return their renewal notice on time to avoid a delay in dispersion of their subscription.

Each FED LOG subscriber is requested to return their FY15 Subscription Renewal Notice before August 20, 2014 to avoid interrupted distribution. The subscription renewal notice will be distributed by U.S. Mail before June 1, 2014. Price changes to FED LOG are

occurring in FY15. For instance, individual account holders who were paying \$17.50 per issue will now be paying \$20.00 per issue.
