



Interacting with NSN Data using Electronic Cataloging (ECAT)

ECAT is a DLA Logistic Information Services Web based application and allows users to submit cataloging requests (for both National Stock Number creation and maintenance) and inquire on the status of previously submitted requests.

ECAT has a wide user base consisting of all Military Services, DLA, US Special Operations Command, Federal Agencies, and international representatives.

Cracking the code for correct disposal of items of supply

Within DLA Logistics Information Services is the DOD Demilitarization (DEMIL) Coding Management Office (DDCMO). The **DDCMO** is responsible for validating the correct DEMIL Code on items of supply owned and used by military services and Federal agencies.

It is imperative that we validate the DEMIL Code to ensure proper disposition, so our warfighters don't face our own technology in the future. In addition, we can ensure that Defense dollars are not wasted by unnecessarily destroying items that could be donated or sold to authorized users.

The **DDCMO** works closely with DLA Disposition Services-Controlled Property Verification Office to ensure the right code,

The **ECAT** of the future will provide greater capabilities to the end user by expanding query functionality, providing more information on submitted requests, and developing more intuitive input screens tailored to the needs of each customer.
