
Special Attention Notice for Attendees to the Parts Standardization and Management Committee (PSMC) meeting at the Boeing plant in Mesa, Arizona in November 2013

1. The plant address is 5000 East McDowell Road, Mesa, AZ, 85215-9707.
2. The Boeing site is a defense contractor facility and has strict security requirements that must be followed by all visitors at all times. Failure to follow the rules may result in your removal from the premises (and probably disciplinary action to me, personally).
3. Boeing is a NO TOBACCO facility. Smokers, spitters, and sniffers have to take it all the way off the property and stand by the street.
4. Park in the area marked for Visitors or in an unmarked parking area only.
5. Visitors enter only through building 510 – next to the large American Flag.
6. All visitors will be issued a badge. The badge must be worn in plain sight at all times. The badge must be returned at the conclusion of your visit at the end of the week.
7. Your badge will require that you are escorted by a Boeing employee at all times. Your escort at least walks you to the bathroom and has to step outside with you if you need to leave the meeting room to take a call. Do not be caught without a Boeing escort by your side.
8. We are expecting about 40 visitors. It will take time to get you all badged at the reception lobby. You can make it easier on yourself and others if you arrive 30 minutes early and are patient. If you must come and go at odd times from the rest of the group make sure that you have your escort by your side.
9. You will be given personal wireless visitors internet access. You must accept the terms and conditions of Boeing provided internet when you log on. Those terms include awareness that Boeing may (does) monitor your network activity. The network is for business purposes only so please stay off your social media such as Facebook and YouTube.
10. **To expedite your badging and internet access please register as early as possible in advance.** Send your full name, Company/Employer name, National Citizenship, city of residence, and company email address. Please let us know if you desire internet access.
11. DO NOT launch your own internet hot spot or we'll spend the rest of the day in Security.
12. The taking of photographs or video is forbidden inside the facility. You may bring a cell phone with a camera into the plant but you must not use the camera function.
13. Boeing has a nice cafeteria and accepts credit cards. An ATM machine is also conveniently placed at the cafeteria front door. You are responsible for your own meals. There are a few vending machines and kiosks around the plant.
14. There is a Boeing Store (gift shop) with Boeing-labeled merchandise for adults and children of all ages. It is attached to the cafeteria so you can find it easily if interested.
15. Weather-wise you can expect sunny skies, light winds, no humidity, highs in the upper 70's to low 80's and lows in the low 50's.
16. We are pleased to provide a group tour of our final assembly area. Be prepared for plenty of walking between buildings – but no stairs on the tour. No sandals or open toe shoes on tour.
17. The building where we are meeting has a long staircase and one small slow elevator. Whatever way you make it up and down the stairs, your escort must always be nearby.

We hope you enjoy your stay in the Valley of the Sun and have a great meeting at our facility.


