- **MIL-STD-3018 Change Notice 2 went out for comment before the spring meeting, with a due date of April 25th. Primarily Paragraph 5.2 changed, the verbiage on the “Order of Preference.”**
 - **The subcommittee discussed comments received pertaining to the proposed 5.2 wording and other aspects of the standard. General comments will be held in abeyance until a full revision of MIL-STD-3018 is done.**



Parts Management Tools and Data Subcommittee



Focused on Standards as Digital Data:

- Promoting / accelerating adoption of digital standards within government / industry.
- The Standards as Digital Data / Ontology Project, with the objective of providing a common structure / taxonomy across the enterprise, an open standard, ultimately owned and maintained by an SDO.
- Discussed the Semantic Web for Interoperable Specs and Standards (SWISS) model at length—what it is, what it does, and its business benefits.



Counterfeit Parts Subcommittee Meeting

- **Considered deliverables the subcommittee could provide. It's difficult to find out what's going on regarding counterfeit mitigation, like for EEE parts.**
 - **The subcommittee could compile a starting list of organizations active in the counterfeit world and consider their charter, current activities, etc.**
 - **Plan to submit a white paper to DSPO, proposing the idea for an entity to capture up-to-date information in a newsletter or website format, including contact information of organizations working counterfeit mitigation.**

Practitioner's Guide:

- **OEMs: Contacted at least two industry reps at this meeting. (Some are already involved.) We plan to get information on their processes to develop a useful practitioner's guide for helping others to implement parts management.**
- **Contract Language:**
 - **Asked for examples of contract language and how it flows down to subcontractors.**
 - **We have boilerplate in MIL-STD-3018 and SD-19.**
 - **Other ways it gets in the contracts.**
