

IGD 1001: ESOHMS POLICY

A. PURPOSE

This IGD ensures the continual development, review, and approval of the DLA-SM Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health Management System (ESOHMS) Policy Statement. This IGD applies to all DLA-SM personnel (HQ and Depots), those working on our behalf, and all applicable business units, and ensures that we adhere to the ESOHMS Policy Statement. The ESOHMS Policy Statement is reviewed at least annually by the Administrator and will be modified, as appropriate, to achieve the DLA-SM ESOHMS objectives.

B. PROCESS

1. ESOHMS Policy Statement

The ESOHMS Policy Statement establishes the framework for DLA-SM environmental, safety, and occupational health functions and activities. The ESOHMS Policy Statement provides the foundation for controlling the environmental impacts; safety and occupational health risks of its activities; commodities; and services; and establishes ESOHMS objectives. The key elements of the ESOHMS Policy Statement include:

- a. Addressing the ESOHMS Policy's support of mission objectives.
- b. Complying with the requirements of all relevant ESOH laws, regulations, and other requirements, and DLA-SM policies and procedures.
- c. Fostering a dialogue with employees, those persons working on behalf of the government within DLA-SM, and the public, regarding the potential impact of our operations, including host and tenant agencies as appropriate.
- d. Promoting a safe and healthy work environment by eliminating hazards and reducing ESOH risks and promoting pollution prevention through environmental stewardship.
- e. Continually improving environmental, safety, and occupational health performance through training and integrating environmental, safety, and occupational health considerations for our business planning processes.

2. Communication of the ESOHMS Policy Statement

The ESOHMS Policy Statement will be communicated and made available, through various media, to all employees, those working on our behalf, contractors, tenants, hosts, and external constituencies, as applicable.
