





# Sustainment Items

## Clothing

- **Combat**
  - Cold Weather Clothing (SRP)
    - Intermediate Cold Weather Glove
    - Long Underwear Systems
    - Utilize Army Design for:
      - Extreme Cold Weather Suit
      - Light Weight Exposure Suit
- **Dress**
  - Female Dress Blue Uniform
  - Improved Barracks Cover
- **Running Shoes**



# Personal Protective Equipment

- Plate Carrier
- ESAPI Plates
- Helmets
  - Maintain ECH (Increased AAO to 182K)
  - Enhanced Combat Vehicle Crewman's Helmet



# Industry Support

- Need for an inexpensive Flame Resistant material or treatment
- Tropical Uniform
- Lighten the load of the Marine
- Infantry Equipping Challenge (IEC)

## First Round Focus Areas

- ▶ **Water purification/filtration systems (Platoon/Squad/Individual level)**
- ▶ **Batteries; rechargeable, improved wear-ability, longer lasting**
- ▶ **Battery recharging to reduce the number carried and service life**
- ▶ **Polymer case ammunition & ammo packaging...reduce weight**
- ▶ **Infantry medical litter...reduce weight & size**
- ▶ **Utility items...Infantry flashlight, Camouflaged gaiter, Head net, etc.**
- ▶ **Packs. Special designs/modifications to accommodate for crew served weapons/assault loads, etc.**
- ▶ **Infantry chow; repackaging to reduce weight/bulk**
- ▶ **Improved undergarments; Quick dry, no drip/melt, anti-microbial**
- ▶ **Improved outerwear; Camouflage all clothing & equipment to include gas mask carrier and tactical outer vests; lighter weight, quicker drying**
