# Strengthening the Domestic Industrial Base

- Actions Taken to Strengthen Domestic Industrial Base
  - Change in payment terms to small business and non-profit agencies to accelerate cash flow
  - Delivery order adjustments to stabilize supply chains
  - Early recompetes for underwater contract pricing
  - Develop of materials related economic price adjustment clause
- Additional Efforts
  - OSD memo on inflation and firm fixed price contracts
  - Data gathering to drive to strategic solutions
    - Supply chain illumination
    - War games scenario



# ICP Objectives

- DLA's Industrial Capability Program (ICP) and Warstopper Program are tasked with identifying supply chain risk and implementing mitigation strategies to sustain a healthy and elastic supplier base ensuring cost-effective Warfighter readiness.
