 - Conductive Materials and Textiles

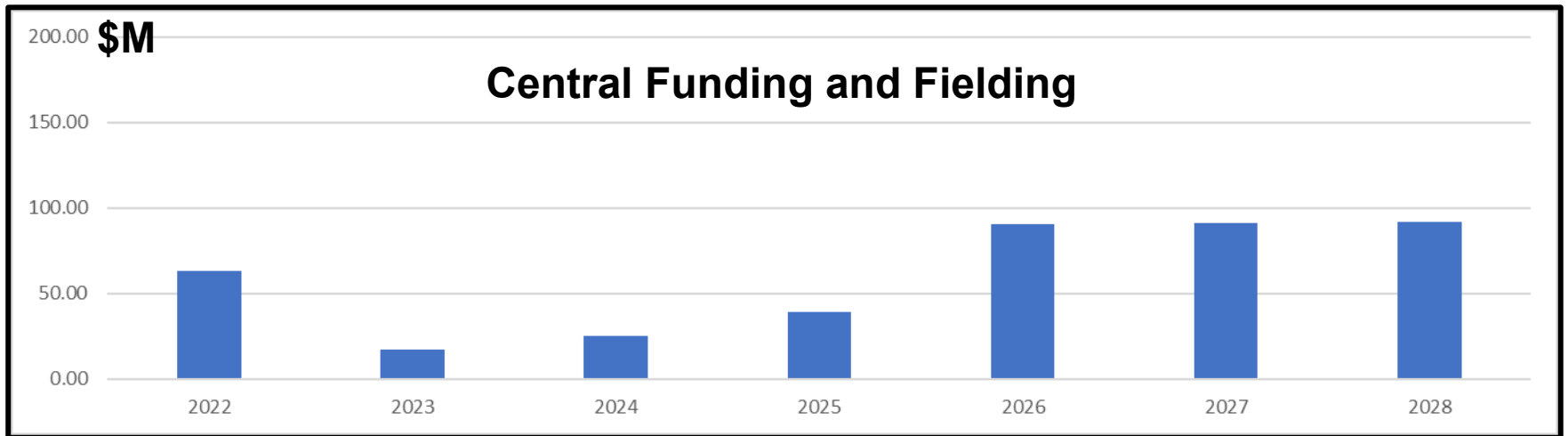
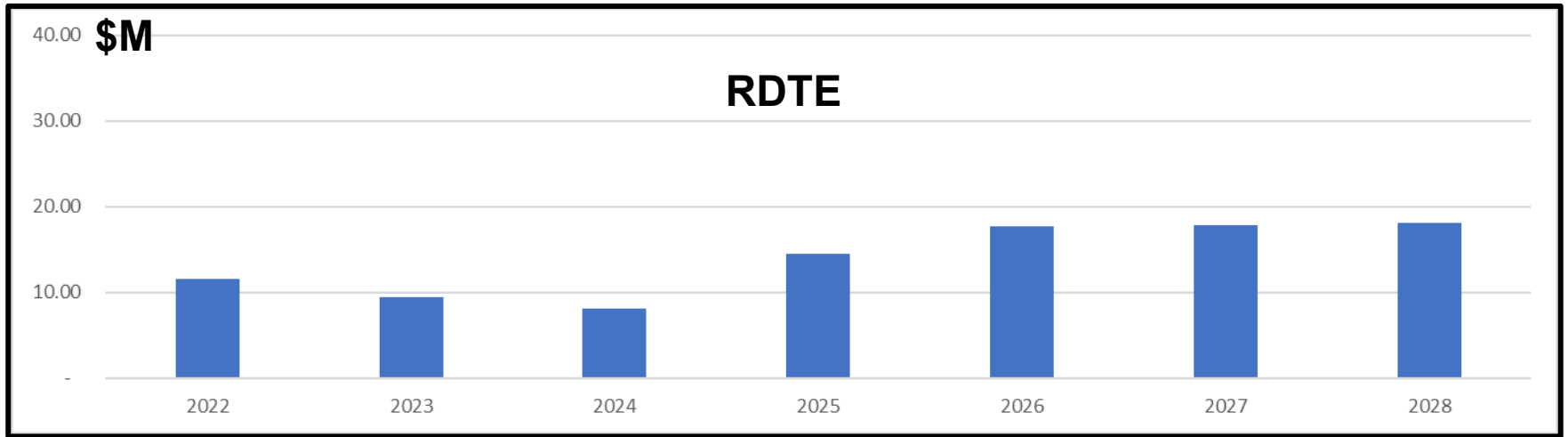


Funding Outlook – Ballistic Protection
