Ms. Patricia Panzera is being inducted into the Defense Logistics Agency Troop Support Hall of Fame, Class of 2022 for her outstanding mission support from 1981 to 2012. Ms. Panzera was an innovative leader of customer relations and process management who dedicated 31 years of federal service to DLA Troop Support.

Ms. Panzera's exceptional acquisition knowledge and leadership skills ensured the men and women serving in the U.S. military experienced superior logistics support, benefited from millions of dollars in cost savings, and most importantly received outstanding customer service. Culminating her career as the Director of the Medical supply chain's Supplier Operations, Ms. Panzera helped provide \$4.6 billion of medical supplies and equipment to America's warfighters and other DLA customers worldwide. She was responsible for facilitating the multi-year, multi-billion-dollar, long-term Medical Prime Vendor contracts through the complex and demanding federal acquisition process, exceeding all expectations of thoroughness, and meeting every contractual and legal requirement.
