Mr. Cardone managed the acquisition process and resources of one of the largest and most diversified procurement missions within the Defense Logistics Agency. His expert management and insight were responsible for implementing a number of programs which benefited DPSC's customers, including United States Beef for Europe which contracted for large quantities of beef, and the Commercial Products program which improved how food is purchased. He also helped shorten the order-ship time to Europe by 15 days resulting in fresher products for European commissary customers.
