

Hall of Fame Inductees

ARTHUR J. JONES

Is inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this sixteenth day of June 1995 for his extraordinary leadership and support as Personnel Officer - and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DPSC – from 1940 to 1965. Mr. Jones optimized his management techniques and expertly engineered the personnel support needed to successfully merge the NY Quartermaster Procurement Agency with Philadelphia’s Quartermaster Depot in 1954. He further demonstrated this talent in preparing for the 1965 consolidation of the Medical, Subsistence, and Clothing & Textile inventory control points to create DPSC. His foresight and positive action was singularly responsible in minimizing the possibility of a “skill drain” within the combined tri-commodity work force at this critical point in DPSC’s development.
