MAJOR GENERAL EMMETT W. BOWERS U.S. ARMY (RETIRED)

Is inducted into the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia Hall of Fame this second day of June 1998 for his extraordinary leadership and support as DSCP's 17th Commander from 1978 through 1981. During General Bowers' impressive tour of duty, he oversaw the transfer of three major food warehouse facilities in Germany from the US Army to DSCP, completing the shift in logistics responsibility and making DSCP the single provider of food. Under his direction, DSCP filled more than 3,800 requisitions for the Cuban Refugee crisis. He instituted a Commander's Hotline to provide an anonymous way to report concerns within DSCP. His advocacy of health and community events was evident by his establishment of the Fitness Center, Commander's Fun Run and Walk and the first DSCP choir.
