EDITH SIANI CAVALIERI IN MEMORIUM

Is posthumously inducted into the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia Hall of Fame this sixteenth day of November 1999 for her continuous mission support from 1939 through 1975. In her 36 years of service, Mrs. Edith A. Siani Cavalieri made herself available day or night for work in the flag shop to meet this nation's needs, and rose in time to become the Flag Shop Supervisor. During her long career, she produced the first United Nations Flag, the first 49 star American Flag when Alaska joined the Union in 1959, and flags that traveled to the moon and back aboard Gemini VII in December 1965. These significant accomplishments and her daily actions will always reflect honor and glory on the workers of the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia.
